



Banquet Rental Frequently Asked Questions

How much is the rental, and what is included?

For the Wallace MacMurray Banquet Room, Sunday through Friday the rental fee is \$500 plus HST, Saturday's rental is \$995 plus HST. Room will be set up (tables, chairs, linens, place settings, mic & podium, AV screen) as per your requirements.

The Canaport LNG Board Room is available for \$175 plus HST for full day rental and holds 20 guests.

How many guests does the room hold?

This will depend on your room and set up requirements. If you have a stage, head table, buffet, DJ playing or a band they will take space that would otherwise be used for tables. Typically for a wedding 180 would be a maximum. If your event is a dinner without DJ or band we can serve 220.

Can we bring in our own food and alcoholic beverages?

To comply with local health regulations and to ensure the safety of all guests Lily Lake Pavilion is the sole provider of all food and beverage with the exception of Wedding Cake, Cupcakes or Candy for a candy bar.

Lily Lake Pavilion is the only party licensed to sell alcohol on the premises. No alcoholic beverages including homemade wine can be brought into the facility. There are no exceptions to this rule.

What can I expect meals to cost?

We have a large variety of options to choose from. For weddings only there is a minimum food order of \$2500. For other event types the cost depends on your menu selection.

Will you provide a bartender?

Yes a bartender is included in the room rental, however if bar sales for your event are less than \$400 an additional charge of \$25/hour. If you would like a second bar, the fee is \$200.

Is there a deposit required?

To confirm your date there is a deposit required that is equal to half of the room rental charge plus HST.

How do I confirm a booking?

To confirm a booking you must review, complete and submit the Room Rental Agreement and Terms and Conditions with your deposit.

What if I have to cancel or postpone my event?

If you have to postpone your event, your deposit will be transferred to your new event booking. In the case of a cancellation there is no refund of any monies paid in deposit. Written notice (email) is required to postpone or cancel your event.
